Section 6

POLICY AND DOCTRINE

MATA Requirements:

1. Involvement with and regular attendance at a home church and /or area church are required during training and service with MATA.
2. Attendance is required at the MATA Friday evening Bible study (7 p.m.) for students and staff. Unexcused absence from the study will preclude any training or aircraft rental for the week following the absence, and continued absences will result in termination of training. Excused absences are for the following reasons only: work requirements (not volunteered extra work), pre-existing involvement in a ministry, out-of-town travel, or other prearranged absences approved by the Director.
3. Students are required to assist for 2 (two) hours a month at the hangar. Work could include maintenance on MATA aircraft, washing aircraft, sweeping/mopping hangar floor, etc. Students are also expected to attend and help at missions conferences, fly-ins, etc. unless excused by the Director. Additionally, students could be called upon for community or ministry service projects.
4. A \$200 balance is to remain on your account throughout the duration of your flight training.



MISSION STATEMENT
